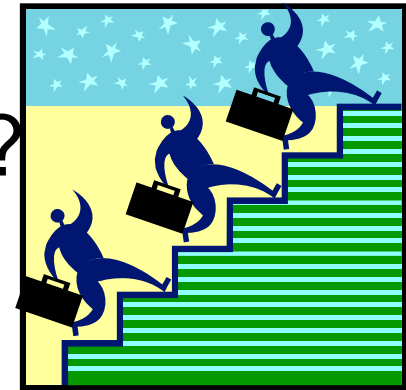

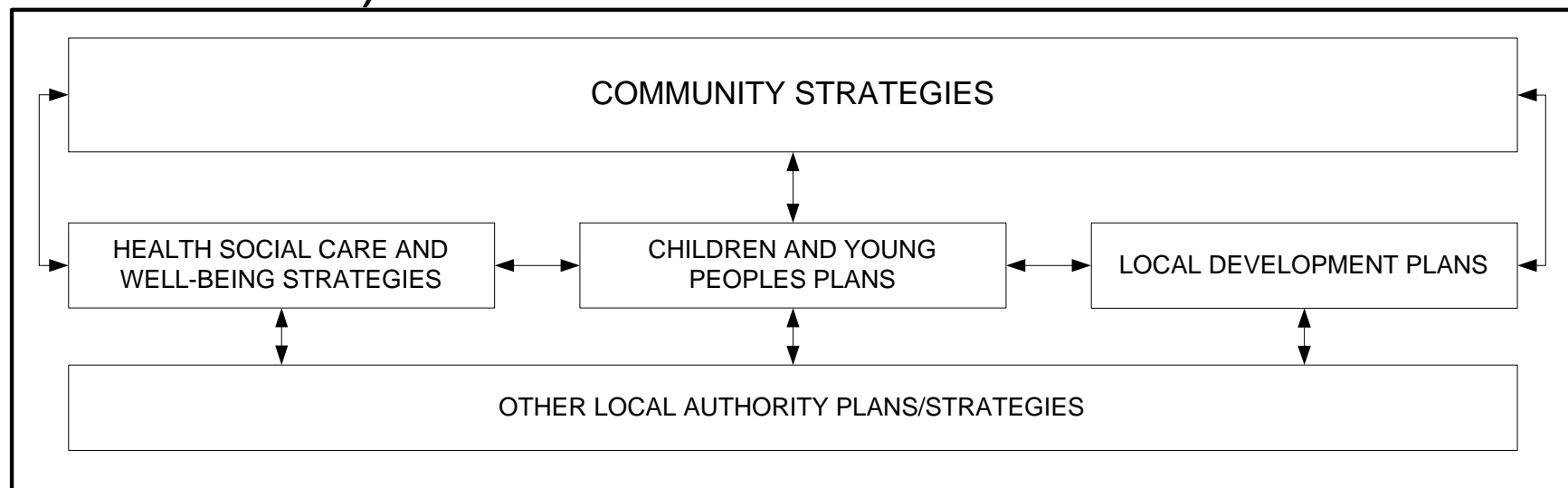

What is the HSCWB Strategy?

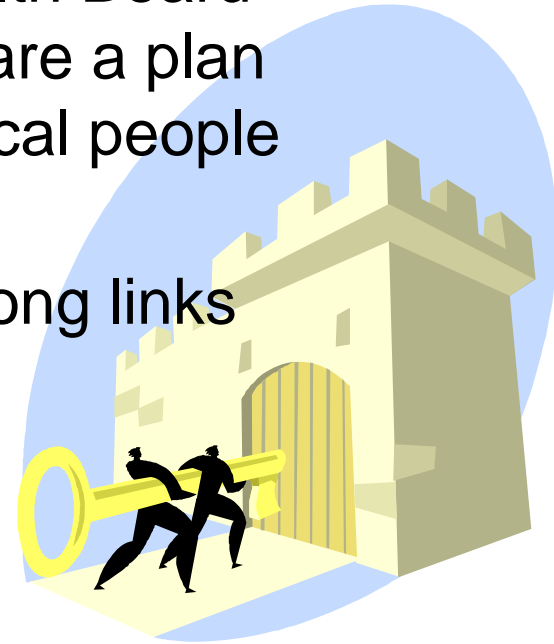


- The Strategy / Plan is now one of the 4 major Strategies/Plans in Denbighshire. It must give a joined response by linking with other big local plans and work with the development of the Community Services Framework (folder attached)



What is Denbighshire's HSCWB Strategy?

- This is the second Health, Social Care & Well-Being Strategy – the first was for 2005-2008
- It is a legal duty that each Local Health Board (LHB) and Local Authority (LA) prepare a plan for the health and well-being of its local people
- It will offer us the chance to have strong links with all local partners.



What is Denbighshire's HSCWB Strategy? (cont)

- Main need for the second round of the Health, Social Care & Well-being plan is that in each area the agreed plan:
 - offer an idea of what the local partnership expect to look like in March 2011
 - The HSCWB Strategy will be the main driver for setting tasks to make health and social care services better!

What is Denbighshire's Health, Social Care & Well-Being Partnership?

- Denbighshire's Health, Social Care & Well-Being Partnership is made up of people from many services.



- A Lead Officer Group (LOG) and Strategic Partnership Board (SPB) made up of key people that will be in charge of the changes within the HSCWB Strategy and the work of the Partnership



How is the Strategy developed?

- A Denbighshire Health, Social Care & Well-Being Needs Assessment was completed in March 2007. The report tells us:
 - where we live and how healthy we are
 - what has been done and what is being done to improve our lives when we are young and as we get older and as the communities we live in change
- The information gathered will help us to decide how to plan for better futures for everyone in Denbighshire
- The Needs Assessment will form the basis of the Strategy
- This needs assessment is on-going, not a one-off exercise

How is the Strategy developed? (cont)



- 8 Themes (subject's) have been agreed to reach our goals
- The Themes (subjects) were agreed by partners involved in workshops, engagement activities etc...
- Each Theme (subject) will include 10 actions and each service user group will have a minimum of 1 action under each of the Themes
- The Strategy's (plans) main beliefs include equalities, public involvement, inclusion and independence
- Each Theme will be followed by an agreed 'Meaning'

What Difference will the HSCWB Strategy Make?



The aims of the HSWB Strategy (plan) are:

- To improve health, social care & well-being for the people of Denbighshire by:
 - **dealing with the full range of issues that affect people's health, social care & well-being**
 - **making the provision, quality and delivery of services which affect health, social care & well-being better; recognising the need to develop services in Welsh and English**
 - **set up a stronger base for planning and looking at performance at a local level;**
 - **Promoting joint working**

What Difference *has* the HSCWB Strategy Made?

- There have been so many positive things since the first Strategy. A Health, Social Care & Well-being Achievements Report has been created to describe what has happened so far.
- Also, there have been some good changes around working together with our partners to deliver services around the needs of users. These joint project developments funded through Joint Working Grant (JWG) funds have been described in an easy to read leaflet

- This is your chance to help shape the next Health, Social Care & Well-being Strategy.



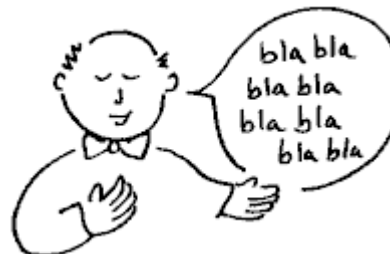

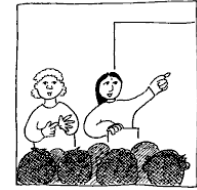

How can you get involved?

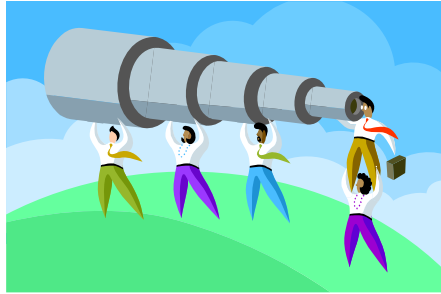


- **There is a planned “discussion/consultation” period from October to December 2007.**
